### **Broward County, Florida Recorder's Office Live with Automated Redaction**

**Maitland, Florida -- (August 1, 2007) --** Aptitude Solutions, a division of Fortune 500 company Fidelity National Information Services, Inc. (NYSE:FNF) and leading provider of innovative technology solutions for county government, including OnCore county recording and workflow management systems, tax deed filing systems, document management systems and court case management systems, today announced the implementation of aiREDACT automated redaction technology at Broward County, Florida Recorder's office.

Broward County, Florida Recorder's office has taken advantage of the aiREDACT technology, which is integrated with the OnCore Recording System to capture redaction candidates as documents are added to the Official Records. OnCore utilizes up-front scan technology that completely digitizes the official record indexing and recording process, thus reducing internal paper flow and expediting the document recording process. This solution enhances automation in the overall recording process, thus increasing the accuracy of locating sensitive information.

Broward has implemented aiREDACT to handle redaction of sensitive information on a historical and go-forward basis. aiREDACT integrates into the OnCore workflow automatically locating redaction candidates which are then placed in a review queue. aiREDACT is compliant with State requirements for the protection of sensitive personal information including but not limited to social security numbers, bank account numbers, credit and debit account numbers, and more.

*President Paul Miller explains, "With one of the highest recording volumes in the country, logging record high volumes of over 8,000 documents per day, Broward County, Florida is a solid candidate for automating redaction through OCR technology. aiREDACT provides the efficiency and reliability necessary for a county of this size to meet legislative demands for securing public records."*

With over 55 million images in the Broward Official Records, the task of redacting sensitive information within those records is a monumental undertaking. aiREDACT gives the Broward County Recording Department the ability to quickly locate and redact the information within these records and allows them to meet the legislative deadline in 2008.
