## Duval County, Florida Clerk of Court Live with ShowCase Felony and Juvenile

The implementation of Felony and Juvenile completes the implementation of all criminal departments in the Duval Clerk of Courts office.

Last month Aptitude Solutions implemented Misdemeanor, Traffic and Appeals into live production. With the addition of Felony and Juvenile, Showcase is now live on over 200 user workstations in the Duval Clerk's office. The implementation of Showcase represents a two year initiative in which Aptitude Solutions and the Duval Clerk of Courts office worked together to develop this state of the art system. Showcase has been designed to offer the latest tools in imaging, workflow, electronic recording, secure internet access to court records, and integrated data transfer between the State Attorney's office, Jacksonville Sheriff's office and other state and local agencies.

Aptitude Solutions and Duval County plan to implement the Civil modules of Showcase in early 2008. Once development and training on the ShowCase Civil system is completed, Aptitude Solutions will have a totally unified, comprehensive court system for all departments allowing for seamless search and retrieval of case files within the Duval Clerk's office. Showcase has been designed with an intuitive user interface and a flexible management system. The application allows users to quickly enter case information and aids in cross training employees. The flexible management tools enable the County to be efficient in modifying system settings to guarantee adherence to the ever changing nature and requirements placed upon the Clerk's court and information technology staff.

With Traffic, Misdemeanor, Appeals, Felony and Juvenile now live, the Aptitude team will move on to the Civil departments to bring them up live on the system within the coming months. One of the major goals for Duval County during the development of ShowCase was to provide in-court processing for the Judges and Clerks staff to eliminate a large amount of post court processing, which the Clerks offices typically perform. In addition to in court processing, the system is integrated with numerous local and statewide agencies, which eliminates redundant data entry. For example, Showcase communicates through a broker server with the Jacksonville Sheriff's office to facilitate immediate data sharing and transfer. When Misdemeanor and Felony cases are entered, the user enters a few simple key pieces of data, which then pulls all of the arrest and booking information, including the charges, into the system for speeding and simplifying data entry.
